ENTRY To submit your entry, take a photo of yourself holding the book (or at the event) and tag us (@eplsdotorg on Instagram or Twitter and @everettlibrary on Facebook). You may also pick up a reading challenge checklist and return your completed challenge at either Everett Public Library location.

The photo and hashtag will together be referred to as an "entry." Photos must be in a format compatible with Facebook or Instagram's file format and size restrictions. Unlimited entries are permitted during the promotion, but only one prize will be awarded per account.

All entries must comply with the entry requirements specified below. Any entry that does not comply with the entry requirements will not be eligible for entry into the promotion. Entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. PT on December 31, 2020 to be eligible for consideration.

No correspondence about entries will be entered into, nor will entries be acknowledged as received. If all required information is not included, entry will be disqualified. EPL is not responsible for late or incomplete entries.

By entering this promotion, the entrant gives their consent for EPL to use photo for promotional and marketing purposes.
